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In order to be eligible for the rebate within the program to subsidize and encourage the replacement of regular-flow toilets with low-flush ones, you must:

- Step 1 **Please note:** Read over all the terms and conditions of the low-flow toilet rebate program in order to comply with the qualifying conditions.
- Step 2 Between January 1 and December 31 of the current year, select and purchase an eligible low-flow toilet model (while the program is in effect).
- Step 3 Take a photo (minimum size: 3 inches x 5 inches) of the old toilet(s) before replacing it (them). Sign and date the photo on the back.
- Step 4 Install the new toilet(s) or have it (them) installed in a residential single-family or multi-family building, with a maximum of 4 dwelling units, and served by the municipal sanitary sewer or water supply infrastructures (maximum 4 toilets per eligible building).
- Step 5 Take a photo (minimum size: 3 inches x 5 inches) of the new toilet(s) installed. Sign and date the photo on the back.
- Step 6 Submit the duly completed rebate application form by January 31, 2010 at the very latest and enclose a bill for the purchase* of the toilet(s) as well as the photo(s) of the toilet(s) to be replaced and the new one(s) installed. Send everything to:

- Step 7 Allow a representative of Ville de Laval to check, on site, whether the information submitted is in keeping with requirements.

*The bill of purchase must identify the name and contact information of the retailer, the date of purchase and full information making it possible to identify the name of the distributor as well as the name and number of the toilet model. If the proof of purchase doesn't contain all the required information, the owner will have to provide the missing information on a document enclosed with the bill.
